## Terms and conditions

1. The Contest is open to any individual or organisation (e.g. company, business or institution) in any country.
2. The closing date and time for receipt of Entries is November 15, 2008, 12.00 CET. Entries receive confirmation only by e-mail from the EVD, that can constitute as proof of receipt.
3. All entries shall be evaluated based on the following criteria:
  1. Originality, specified as unique and your own idea;
  2. Expected effectiveness, defined as the impact on the goals of the assignment
  3. Executability; defined as: can the idea be executed and can it be repeated over time and place;
  4. Fitting in the Holland Branding concept, as specified below
  5. Costs, defined as: can the idea be executed below the 500.000 euro's (VAT included)
4. The jury has the right to exclude entrees if:
  1. the entree is too late, incomplete, false or not declared lawfully signed
  2. the entree is not in the Dutch or English language
  3. the own declaration is not confirmed
  4. all required fields of the submission questionnaire are incomplete
5. To enter the Contest each participant must submit via the website [www.orangecontest.nl](http://www.orangecontest.nl)
6. The entry is the original creation of the participant, being able to declare ownership in a formal manner.
7. Entering the Contest is free of costs, but each participant bears himself any costs of researching, preparing and submitting of his/her entry.
8. Submitted entries that reach the final, including any material related hereto shall become the sole property of the EVD and shall not be returned.
9. All Entries not selected for the final will learn so by e-mail before December 3, 2008. Participants can object to the jury's decision through a civil procedure, no later than . 15 days after the finalists have been announced.
10. the EVD or the hosting organisations of the Contest, The Ministry of Economic Affairs and the Innovation Platform reserve the right to stop or temporarily set the contest on hold.
